NOTICE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS

Each year the Sussex Police Authority's accounts are audited and any person interested has the opportunity to inspect and make copies of the accounts and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating to them. For the year ending 31 March 2009, these documents will be available on application to the Director of Resources, Police Headquarters, Lewes, East Sussex BN7 2DZ (Telephone: 01273 404008) between 9.00 am and 4.30 pm on weekdays between Thursday 18 June and Friday 17 July 2009.

Local government electors and their representatives also have:

- (1) the opportunity to question Helen Thompson, the District Auditor, about the accounts. The District Auditor or her representative will be at 2nd Floor, The Agora, Ellen Street, Hove, BN3 3LN for this purpose on Friday 17 July 2007 at 10.00 am;
- (2) the right to attend before the District Auditor and make objections to the accounts or any items in them. Written notice of an objection must first be given to the District Auditor and a copy sent to the Chief Executive to the Police Authority at the address given below.

The audit is being carried out by the District Auditor, the Audit Commission, Suite 2, Bicentennial Building, Southern Gate, Chichester, West Sussex, PO19 8EZ (Telephone 0844 798 1600 www.audit-commission.gov.uk) and will be conducted under the provisions of the Audit Commission Act 1998 and the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2003.
